

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum is signed between Sindh Prisons & Corrections Service through its Inspector General hereinafter called as Party-01 having its office at Muslimabad, Karachi, Sindh, Pakistan

and

Trust Jamiat Talim-ul-Quran through its Chief Executive Officer hereinafter called as Party-02, having its registered office inside Alamgir Masjid, Alamgir Road, Bahadurabad, Karachi, Pakistan.

JTQ was established in 1969 and is registered under Society Act 1860. It was established with a Vision of teaching Quranic Tajweed, Nazra and Hifz to the children of Pakistan across all cities, areas and streets. It now has more than 2,800 Quran schools across the country, from Karachi to Gilgit, in urban, rural, and even remote/less privileged areas, where JTQ is providing free Quranic and basic Islamic education to children. Currently, there are more than 60,000 students who are being taught by our appointed Certified teachers.

In addition to this, JTQ have Jail Makatib in 84 prisons in all provinces of Pakistan except Sindh, where prisoners are provided with Quranic teachings, and basic Islamic education and values without any discrimination. In fact, JTQ is the only organization that is allowed to work for the welfare of inmates in Punjab.

Whereas, both parties are interested to work together for the benefit and welfare of Prisoners in such number of prisons as and when notified.

Both parties agree to the terms of this MoU as follows:

Responsibilities of Party-02

1. JTQ will arrange trainings for inmates. List of trainings are mentioned in Appendix A. Trainings may be provided directly by JTQ's Employees or arranged through a 3rd party agreement.
2. JTQ will invest in developing facility (or facilities), necessary for trainings. Investment will be on Tangible items and will remain property of JTQ.
3. JTQ will make sure trainers are experienced individuals and of Moral character and are not involved in any illegal activity whatsoever.

Responsibilities of Party-01

1. Trainings will be approved by Prison Authorities for such prisons on individual basis through separate and subsequent orders issued from time to time. Those orders will become part of this MoU.
2. Party-01 will give final clearance to the Trainer after checking his/her background.
3. Party-01 will provide necessary operational help in developing the facility, like Room, electricity etc.

In case of any ambiguity or any issue, Party-01 and Party-02 will establish a technical committee, having representation from both sides, who will solve the issue.

This MOU is valid for 03 years from the date of signing and both parties shall be at the liberty to withdraw from this MOU prematurely by prior notice.

This MoU is signed by individuals having authority in their respective organizations.


